

The Opportunity

GROWTH IN A MOUNTAIN TOWN

As a small department in a connected community, this is a "Working Chief" role that will need to balance work out in the community including patrolling, responding in the field, and engaging in community policing while managing and leading in more administrative duties.

With a seven-member Board of Trustees that governs the town and is supportive of the department, funds have been committed with a goal of doubling personnel within the next 3-5 years.

Granby is also a town that respects and appreciates their officers, with less major crime than many metropolitan areas. The Chief will be responsible for maintaining this environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

Evaluate evidence, witnesses, and suspects in criminal cases to assess trends, similarities, or associations with other cases

Promote an inclusive departmental culture and ensure policing practices reflect the Town's commitment to equity

Ensure department personnel are receiving timely and relevant training in accordance with staff positions and certifications

Evaluate the work of department personnel and establish priorities including overseeing formal performance reviews

Coordinate, administer, and monitor police officers at work

Assign officers to special investigations

Participate in patrol officer duties and field work as needed

Prepare Police Department annual budget and provide monthly forecasts of expenditures

Direct how systems, records, and legal documents are maintained

Serve as the primary department administrator for state and federal grants, infrastructure, and equipment purchases.

Serve as a department liaison with the East Grand School District administration and oversee the School Resource Officer (SRO) program appropriate

Compensation & Benefits

- ► **Salary:** \$125,000 \$175,000
- ► **Retirement Plan:** 401(a) contribution from the town equal to 11.2% base pay + mandatory 8% match into a 457(b) plan.
- ► Paid Time Off: Biweekly accrual of 6.77 hours of PTO + 11 paid holidays.
- ▶ **Other:** Rich benefit package including medical, dental, vision, disability, and life insurance.

OUTDOOR OPPORTUNITIES

Living in Granby means having access to all kinds of worldclass outdoor recreation opportunities. Summer, fall, winter or spring, our location in the heart of the Rocky Mountains allows local residents and visitors to enjoy downhill skiing and snowboarding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, fishing, camping, hiking, biking, golfing, rafting, horseback riding, and an array of other exciting outdoor activities.



A TOURIST DESTINATION

In Granby, you'll see year-round tourism. On our busiest weekends, the Town can see an influx of 8,000-10,000 visitors.



LIVING IN GRANBY

The Grand County School District serves the Granby community with 3 of the 4 schools located in Granby's city limits. Affordable housing opportunities may be available at the Town of Granby owned development Nuche Village.



TRANSPORTATION

Exciting developments in transportation are taking place in Granby. In 2025, the Town launched "Granby Connect," an on-demand ride share service. Additionally, Mountain Rail is planned to be available in Granby in late 2026 which would create a network of passenger rail lines that connect the mountain towns and regions with urban centers and recreational locations.



M LOOKING FORWARD

Over the next 10 years, it's expected that 50-75 new homes per year will be built to serve this growing community. Additionally, the Town recently purchased 750 acres of conservation area in Granby with a possibility of establishing a rec center and creating more trails for the community. Additionally, both a park master plan and a downtown master plan are in the works.
