2017 PERF LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Police Executive Research Forum (PERF) is now accepting nomination letters for its 2017 Leadership Award, to be presented at PERF's Annual Meeting, May 30 – June 2, at The Bellagio in Las Vegas.

PERF's Leadership Award is presented to an individual who has made outstanding contributions to the field of law enforcement. The PERF Leadership Award recognizes an individual who exemplifies the highest principles and standards of a true leader in policing on a national level. The award recognizes innovators whose efforts serve as a model to the law enforcement community and whose vision of policing can be applied on a wide scale.

The award is not limited to police practitioners. Anyone who has worked to promote professionalism in the field and has developed ways of improving the delivery of police services is eligible.

In selecting the award recipient, PERF's Board of Directors will consider nomination letters that PERF receives, as well as any additional candidates nominated by a Board member. The award will be presented on Thursday morning, June 1, 2017, during the Town Hall Meeting.

Nominations may consist of a letter of no more than two pages, and the nominee's résumé. Nomination letters of more than two pages and additional materials, such as newspaper articles or videotapes, are not necessary. Please submit your nomination to:
